**DAY 01 APRIL 03 MANILA – AUCKLAND**

Depart Manila on a prestigious airline. Enjoy in-flight meals and entertainment.

**DAY 02 APRIL 04 AUCKLAND**

Arrival in Auckland. Enjoy the sceneries as you transfer to your hotel. The rest of the day is free for your own leisure. Enjoy your night in the hotel for tomorrow will be a great day to explore the city!

**DAY 03 APRIL 05 AUCKLAND**

Travel through Westhaven Marina, New Zealand's largest pleasure boat marina, past the America's Cup Village then along Queen Street, the main commercial business centre, and past Auckland University. From here we will take you on to the volcanic crater of Mt Eden, once a fortified Maori stronghold, where you will enjoy spectacular 360 degree views of the city and harbour. Continue on to Bastion Point via Parnell Village for stunning views of the Waitemata Harbour.

**DAY 04 APRIL 06 AUCKLAND-WAITOMO-ROTORUA**

Breakfast inside the hotel, you will be headed to Rotorua but first, you'll have a guided tour of the Waitomo Caves with a short boat ride through the famous Glow-Worm grotto. The Waitomo Caves are villages and cave system forming a major tourist attraction in the southern Waikato region of the North Island of New Zealand, 12 kilometres northwest of Te Kuiti. The community of Waitomo Caves itself is very small, though the village has many temporary service workers living there as well. These Caves are believed to be over two million years old. Then en route to Rotorua for dinner and overnight.

**DAY 05 APRIL 07 ROTORUA**

Have a full breakfast inside the hotel. Visit to Rotorua's top attractions! Visit Matamata to see Hobbiton Set. Then, discover the wonder of Agrodome Fram, hand-feed the animals and taste some kiwi fruit juice (pay on the spot). Entrance to Rainbow Springs and Agrodome Sheep Show included. Before transferring to hotel, explore Te Puia (New Zealand Maori Arts and Crafts Institute & Whakarewarewa Thermal Valley).

**DAY 06 APRIL 08 ROTORUA - WELLINGTON**

Today, you will be headed to Wellington. Visit Dunedin via Lake Taupo and Tongariro National Park. This park was established in 1887, Tongariro was the first national park in New Zealand and the fourth in the world. It is also a dual World Heritage area, a status which recognises the park's important Maori cultural and spiritual associations as well as its outstanding volcanic features. Dinner and overnight.

**DAY 07 APRIL 09 WELLINGTON - PICTON - CHRISTCHURCH**

After breakfast, board the Inter-Islander ferry to Picton. Connect the Intercity coach to Christchurch. **Christchurch** is the largest city in the South Island of New Zealand, and the country's second-largest urban area. The city was named by the Canterbury Association, which settled the surrounding province of Canterbury.

**DAY 08 APRIL 10 CHRISTCHURCH - QUEENSTOWN**

After breakfast, take the express coach direct to Queenstown. Upon arrival, you will be transferred to your hotel for check in. The rest of the day is free.

**DAY 09 APRIL 11 MILFORD SOUND DAY EXCURSION**

Breakfast inside the hotel. Today, have an excursion to scenic Milford Sounds. Follow the Lake Wakatipu to Lumsden and then onward to Lake Te Anau. Enter the Eglington Valley and travel through Homer Tunnel, this is a road tunnel in the Fiordland region of the South Island of New Zealand, opened in 1954. to reach Milford Sounds.

**DAY 10 APRIL 12 QUEENSTOWN**

Breakfast inside the hotel. Queenstown is the New Zealand destination for international visitors. Its natural beauty changes with the seasons, the lake gleams in the summer sun, and snow clad mountains tower above the township in winter. Half day tour of Lord of the Rings Film location.

**DAY 11 APRIL 13 QUEENSTOWN - MT. COOK - CHRISTCHURCH**

From Queenstown to Christchurch. Visit Mt. Cook National Park travel through the Central Otago Region to Lake Pukaki and Mt. Cook, or as has known in Maori 'Aorangi' the cloud piercer. Visit the Church of Good Shepherd at Lake Tekapo. The Church sits literally only a few from the shores of the turquoise coloured, glacier-fed Lake Tekapo and a large panoramic window behind the altar is deliberately clear to allow uninterrupted lake and mountain views. This church captures the heart of many couples as a venue of their

wedding because of its very romantic setting. Later, travel to Christchurch for an overnight.

**DAY 12 APRIL 14 DEPART CHRISTCHURCH - SINGAPORE**

After breakfast, pick-up and transfer to the airport by shuttle service. Arrived in Singapore in the afternoon. Transfer to hotel.

**DAY 13 APRIL 15 SINGAPORE – MANILA**

Breakfast inside the hotel. Check out, then a guide will introduce you to this tiny yet very beautiful and neat land of Singapore, also known as Lion City. Explore the city by driving round the Civic District, passing by the Padang, Cricket Club, historic Parliament House, Supreme Court and City Hall. Next, you will stop at the Merlion Park and enjoy the impressive views of Marina Bay. Do not miss to take a picture of The Merlion, a mythological creature that is part lion and part fish. Then you will visit Thian Hock Keng Temple, one of Singapore's oldest Buddhist-Taoist temples, before driving past Chinatown. Stop by a Local Handicraft Centre and observe up-close craftsmen at work. Proceed to the National Orchid Garden, located within Singapore Botanic Gardens, which boasts a sprawling display of 60,000 orchid plants. Our final stop at Little India will give you a scent of joss sticks, jasmine and spices. Then, transfer to airport for your flight back to Manila.
